



## **Expectations of Board Members**

1. To faithfully support the mission and objectives of the Association of fundraising Professionals, Greater Cleveland Chapter.
2. To adhere to the Donor Bill of Rights and the Code of Ethical Principles and Standards of Professional Practice as given by AFP.
3. To meaningfully participate in AFP board meetings by active involvement in an assigned area (discussed during the nomination process). This includes participating as an officer, a committee chair, or active participation on a committee. Those not selecting a service area will be assigned to one.
4. To be actively involved with National Philanthropy Day—to include attending the event and making sponsorship calls - as well as other AFP activities (orientation, board retreat, professional development programs etc.).
5. To attend at least 2/3 of all board meetings each year. The board meets every other month starting January.

To financially support the AFP Chapter Be the Cause Campaign as a philanthropic priority to achieve 100% board participation.
