

AFP Greater Cleveland Chapter Mentee Application Form

The AFP Greater Cleveland Chapter provides chapter members with one-on-one assistance to enhance their knowledge and skills as development professionals. Participation as a mentee is available to AFP Greater Cleveland Chapter members who have worked as a full-time paid development professional at a nonprofit organization for a minimum of one year. The program is intended for personal professional growth, not for long-term or extensive organizational assistance.

Mentoring occurs for a one year time period. Initial assignment of mentors and mentees is performed by members of the AFP Greater Cleveland Chapter Membership Committee based on completed applications. Details of the interaction are determined by the mentor and mentee, but it is anticipated that mentoring typically involves about two hours per month. While this is a benefit of membership in the AFP Greater Cleveland Chapter and there is no charge for the services, both mentors and mentees are required to complete an evaluation form at the conclusion of the mentoring period.
