

Scholarship Criteria:

- 1. With the exception of the membership scholarship, applicants must be AFPGC members and employed by a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization/registered charity with at least **50**% of the job devoted to development work.
- 2. Only one scholarship per person (excluding education session scholarships) will be awarded in a year. Past recipients must wait one full year before becoming eligible for another scholarship.
- 3. Additional criteria for specific scholarships:
 - Applicants for the AFP International Conference scholarship must never have attended an
 international conference as a registered participant. Preference will be given to newcomers
 to the field of fundraising especially those with less than 3 years of experience.
 - Scholarship recipients for the AFP International Conference and for chapter event must submit an evaluation report about their experience following attendance at the class or conference.
 - Preference for the CFRE/ACFRE exam scholarship will be given to individuals who have already begun the application process
- 4. All awardees will be required to submit a report to the Scholarship Chair detailing their experience at the meeting/conference/course that may be used in AFP materials, website, or newsletter and include a photo
 - All awardees with the exception of winners of "Monthly Professional Development Programs" scholarships will be required to join a committee of their choice
- 5. Past AFP participation and membership can serve as a consideration in the applicant review process.
- 6. Applicant agrees to match funds, if necessary and applicable.
